

# How to Find the Rome 2 Branch

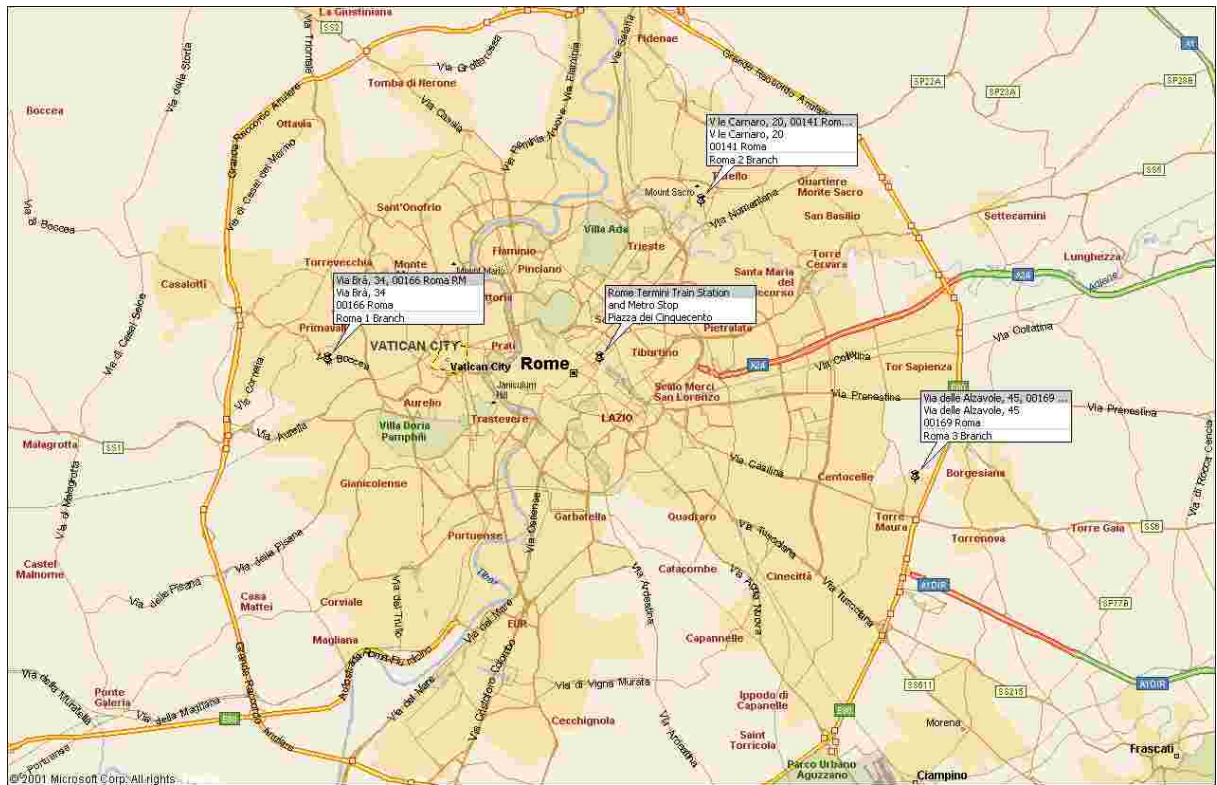
Services are held at Rome 2 at 9:00am until noon each Sunday. Sacrament meeting is last. English translation is provided during Sacrament meeting using headphones for English speaking visitors.

The following maps will help you see how to get there using public transportation.

If you take a taxi from the Termini train station area, it will probably cost about €15 or so.

## Overview Map – 3 branches of Rome

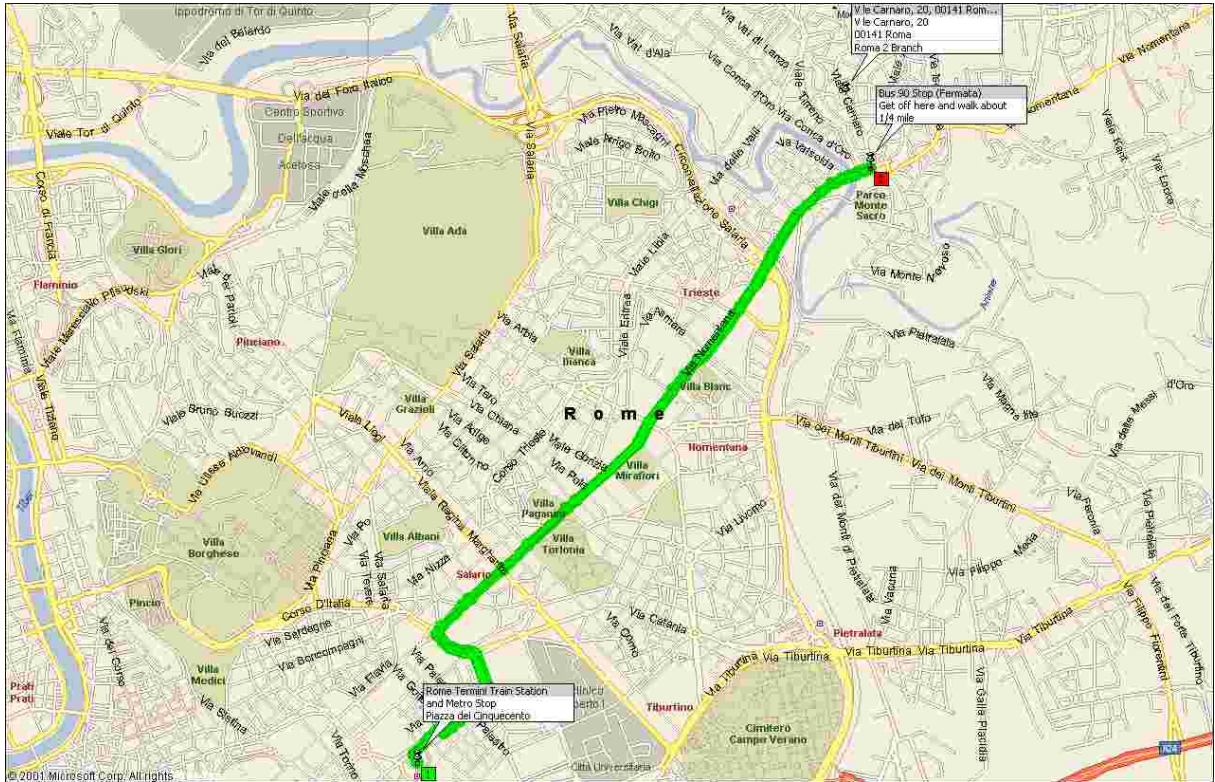


Rome 1 and Rome 3 both start at 9:30am. Rome 3 holds its Sacrament meeting first.

## Taking Bus 90 from Termini Train Station to the Rome 2 Branch

The map below shows the green route for Bus 90 from the Termini train stations.

Get off at Piazza Sempione – the first hard-left the bus will take after a long straight run along Via Nomentana. It will take about 15 minutes from Termini to this stop.



Walk up the hill following the yellow highlighted route on the map below. It will take about 10 minutes to get to the church. After the “Y” fork in the road (you take the left), you’ll pass a small open area with cars parked on the right. Proceed to the next area like this – Piazza Cannaro – the church is located on the south side of this small square or parking area. It is not a separate stand-alone building like in the United States – it is a large rented facility that was formerly a store area. There are no signs that point to it except the standard logo text near the door in Italian: Chiesa di Gesù Cristo dei Santi degli Ultimi Giorni.
